Call for Abstracts

Abstract submission is open.

EURAICA 2027 invites the submission of abstracts for oral **free communications** and **poster presentations**.

Selected oral communications will be presented in one of the two Free Communications sessions of the scientific programme (7 minutes presentation followed by 3 minutes of discussion). All other accepted abstracts will be presented as posters.

Submission deadline: Friday 8 January 2027

Notification of acceptance: by Friday 22 January 2027

Please send your abstract to **contact@euraica.com**, indicating in your message whether you wish to be considered for an oral communication, a poster, or either.

All abstracts must be submitted and presented in clear English, with grammar and spelling of a quality suitable for publication. Please do not submit multiple copies of the same abstract. To correct an abstract already submitted, or to submit an additional one, simply reply to your original submission email.

Abstract topics

Abstracts should address one of the following themes:

- AI-enabled methods already used to generate evidence for regulatory or HTA decision making, and how their robustness is evaluated
- Emerging methods and their qualification: digital twins, synthetic data, disease progression modelling, machine learning within the estimand framework
- Data quality, access and governance for AI-ready clinical evidence
- Generative AI in clinical development and regulatory workflows
- Evaluation frameworks, metrics and validation approaches
- Reusable models and tools versus ad-hoc analyses

Writing and submitting your abstract

Please prepare the following information before submitting:

- Submitting author's contact details (email, phone number, postal address)
- All authors' details (full first and family names, email addresses)
- Affiliation details for each author (institution, company or university, city, state where relevant, country)
- Abstract title
- Abstract text
- Preferred presentation format (oral, poster, or either)
- Selected topic

Title. The title should clearly indicate the nature of the work. Each word should begin with a capital letter, with the exception of transition words. Maximum 15 words.

Length. The abstract body should not exceed 300 words.

Structure. Please structure your abstract using the following headings:

- Background
- Objectives
- Methods
- Results
- Conclusion

Methodological contributions for which this structure does not apply may adapt it, provided the scientific content remains clearly organised.

The abstract should be as informative as possible. Standard abbreviations may be used. Diagrams, tables and images should not be included in the abstract body; they may be presented in the poster or oral communication itself.

Notification and registration

You will receive a confirmation email once your submission has been received. Should you not receive it within two working days, please check your junk folder and contact **contact@euraica.com**. Please note that only abstracts from fully registered presenters can be included in the final workshop programme. **Registration and payment are required by Friday 5 February 2027.** Failure to register by this date may result in your abstract being withdrawn from the programme.
